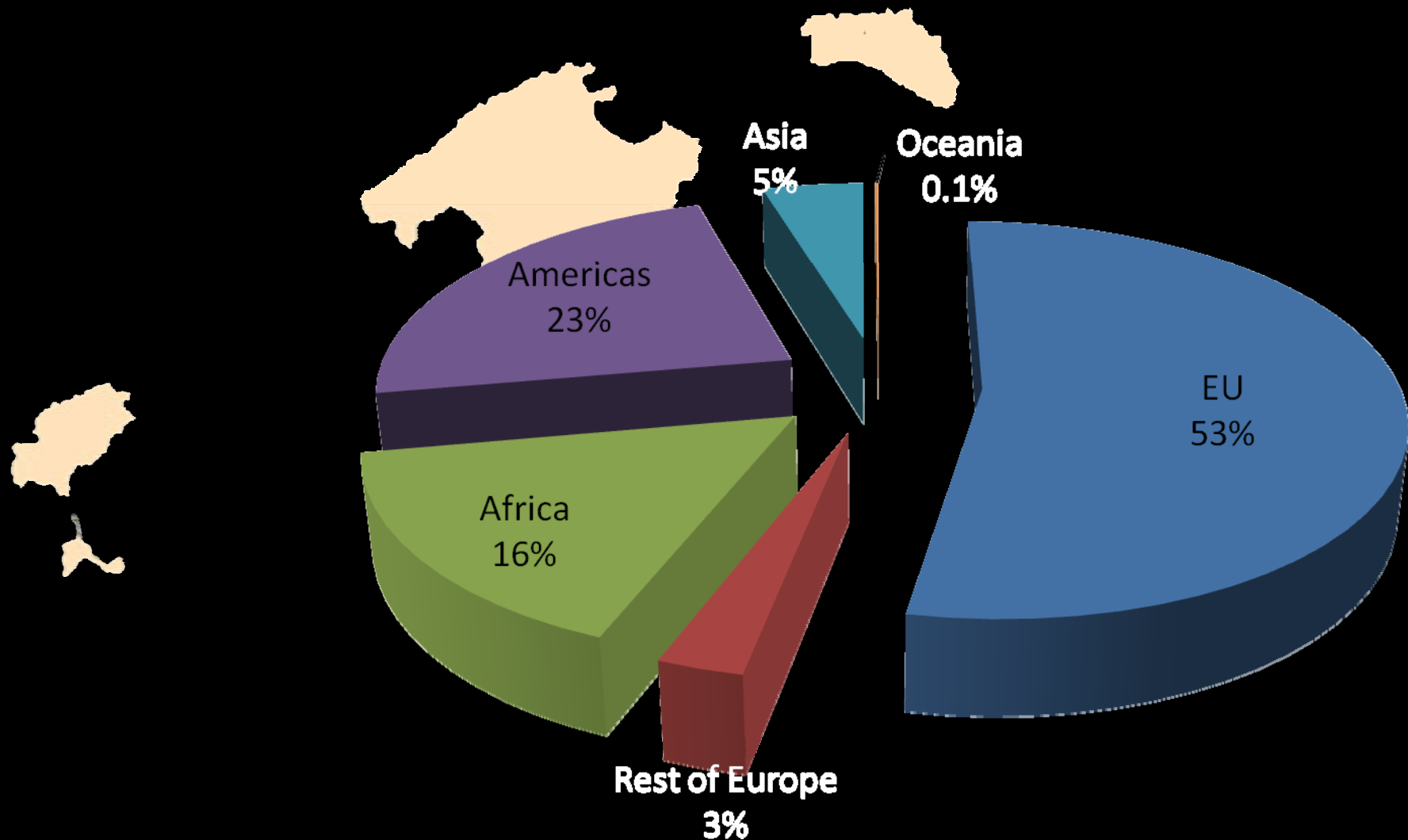


Between 1960 and 1970 the population of the Balearics increased as much as in the previous 50 years together.

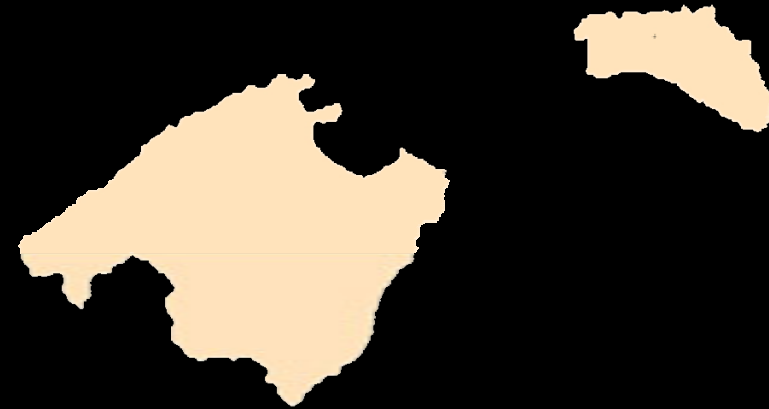

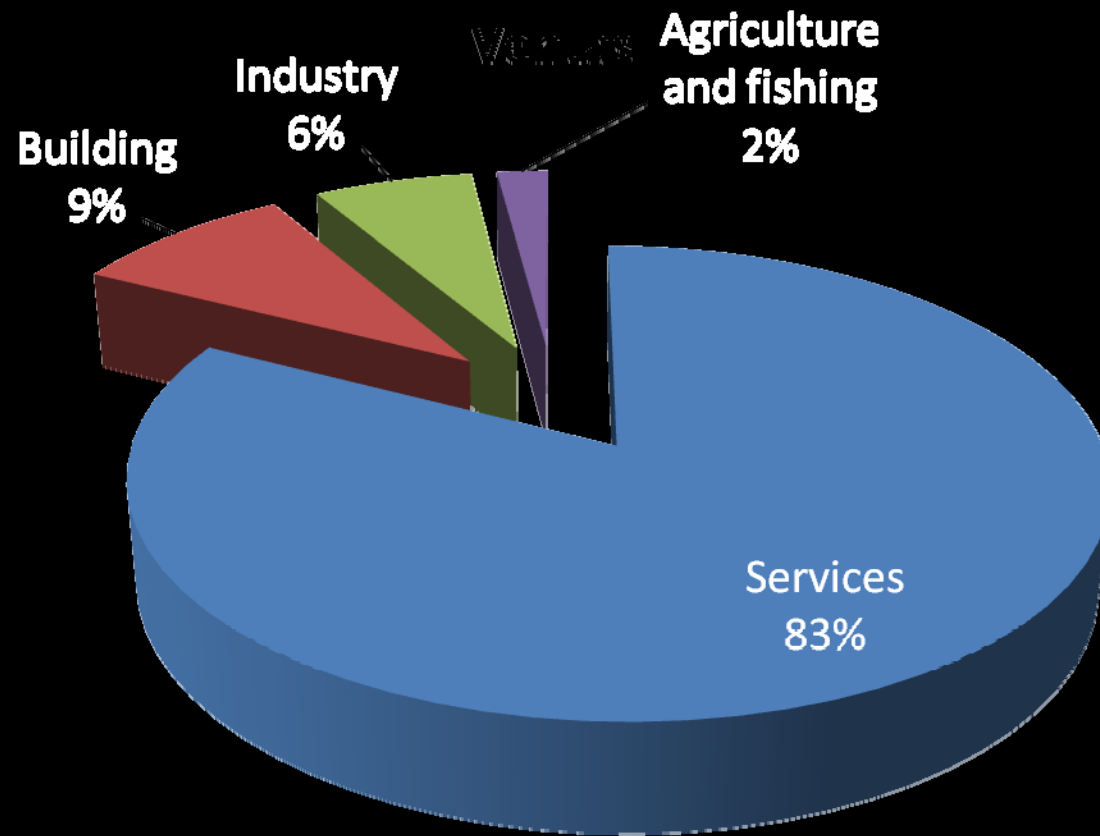

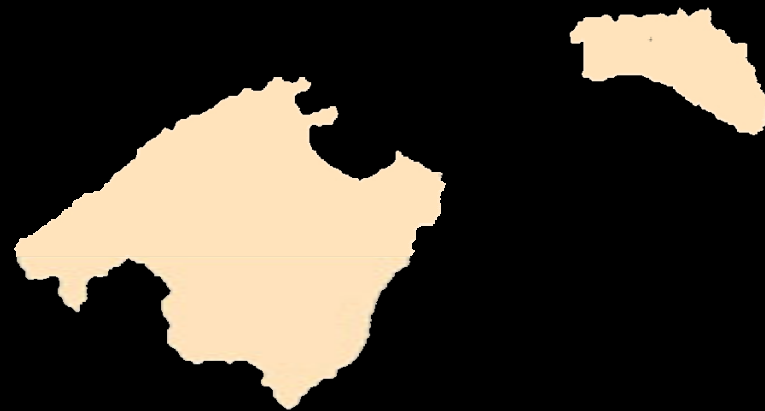


## The fluctuating rate of unemployment
