Key Competence Model

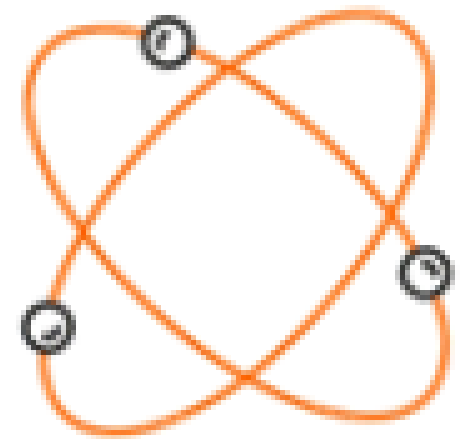
Every educational system sets up a model of citizen and citizenship

In two places:

- UNESCO, 1998
- Council of Europe: Lisbon Conference, 2000

Key competences (EU key competences)

1. Communication in the mother tongue
2. Communication in foreign languages
3. Mathematical competence and basic competences in science and technology
4. Digital Competence
5. Learning to learn
6. Social and civic competences
7. Sense of initiative and entrepreneurship
8. Cultural awareness and expression



Key Competence Model in Spain

- Competence in language communication
- Mathematical competence and basic competences in science and technology
- Digital competence
- Competence to learn to learn
- Sense of initiative and entrepreneurship
- Consciousness and cultural expressions
- Social and civic competences

Universal Soft Skills

Soft skills are character traits and interpersonal skills that characterize a person's relationships with other people.
